## L.E. "Whitey" Reiter, 70

WEST YELLOWSTONE — Private family memorial services were this week for longtime West Yellowstone resident L.E. "Whitey" Reiter, 70, a retired service station owner.

Mr. Reiter died Thursday at the state Hospital at Galen.

A native of Pittsburgh, Pa., he was born Aug. 22, 1915, to Frank H. and Rose Entinger Reiter. He attended schools in Pittsburgh and later worked winters helping build the Inland Canal at Del Rey Beach, Fla., and spent summers in West Yellowstone working in service stations.

In 1937, he moved permanently to West Yellowstone where he worked as a mechanic until he bought the Standard Service Station and Garage at the entrance to Yellowstone Park in 1948. He operated it until his retirement in 1978.

He was a member of the Catholic Church, Knights of Columbus and Elks Lodge 463 of Bozeman. He was also a charter member of the West Yellowstone Lions Club and served on the board of directors of the Chamber of Commerce.

He and Patricia Scully married Nov. 24, 1945, at Laurin. She survives.

Also surviving are a daughter, Rosemary Bowker of Kalispell; sons, Michael of Fiddletown, Calif., James of West Yellowstone, Patrick of Three Forks and John of Billings; and seven grandchildren.
